To perforate and sand-water from the Pictured Cliffs pay zone. To run approximately 3150' of 1 1/4" KUE tubing and to complete and produce as a Pictured Cliffs Gas Producer.

To comply with the rules and regulations of the U.S.G.S. and New Mexico Oil and Gas Commission.

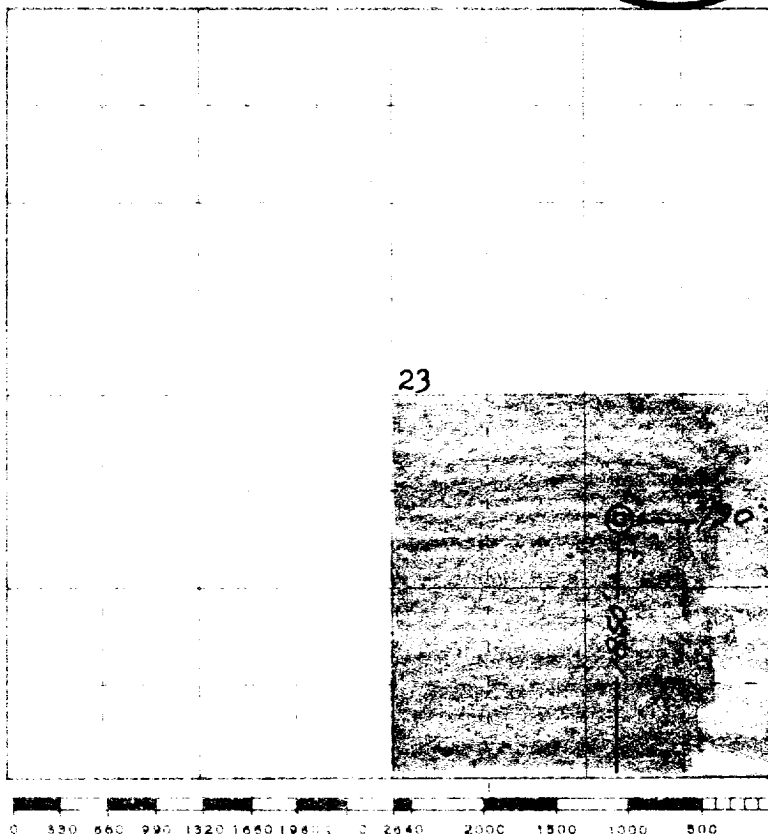
