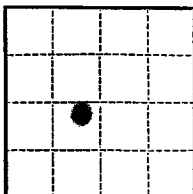

DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to operate perforation at 6100-65 with 25 one regular cement; cut 24 casing at a 2000' and cut a 30-casing over stub; place a plug from 1077-1078, 1090-1091, 1095-1100; place a 25-casing plug over the end of surface pipe and a 2-casing plug at surface with cement.

There has been no show of oil or gas in this well.
