Our original intention was to drill this well to a total depth of about 3000 feet and test the Point Lookout of the Monarda formation, however, on determination that the Ajo Alto formation and the Pictured Cliff formation were encountered structurally low and that the Pictured Cliffs contained water it was decided to drill the well only to a total depth of 1346. A subsequent report of abandonment will follow this report.
