Dear Doug:

I have received your letter of December 21, 1960, along with a Request for Allowable for your #6-Y Stromberg well in Unit C, Section 34-23N-3W.

In order to determine the present status of the 6-Y Stromberg I pulled the file and find that the entire situation is a little confused with regard to the three wells drilled in this quarter-section. We do have well records and plugging notices on the #6 and #6-X wells. In order to complete the file on the 6-Y it will be necessary that you file an additional Well Record with the U.S.G.S. so that they may send us copies. It will also be necessary that you file Form C-110, which is our transporter's form, in order that we may send the transporter an approved copy. It also appears that most of the original information was filed with M.J. Florance as operator. Will you please also indicate on the Form C-110 that the property has been transferred and the effective date of transfer.

As our file on this well is somewhat confused I would also appreciate it if you would write us a letter in duplicate briefly reviewing the history of drilling on this quarter-section, starting with the #6 and continuing to the 6-X and 6-Y wells.

I would also like to extend my sympathy on the death of your father.

I have received your letter of December 10, 1946, and in reply
I enclose herewith the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission
Form No. 1 (Rev. 1-1-46).

In order to determine the present status of your oil property
I require the title and find that the same is owned by
Little Colorado and is subject to the three wells listed in this
correspondence. As the wells are well recorded and producing and are
on the 40-acre well. In order to complete the title on
a 40-acre well it will be necessary that you file an additional
title record with the U.S.D.C. as that filing is required as per
it will also be necessary that you file Form O-110, which
our representative form, in order that we may end the trans-
fer of a proposed copy. It also appears that out of the
only oil property was filed with the U.S.D.C. as per our reports
will be placed into the case on the 11th day of the month
I have enclosed and the effective date of transfer.

As the title on the well is not yet recorded, I would like to specify
it if you could write me a letter in duplicate, one by return
