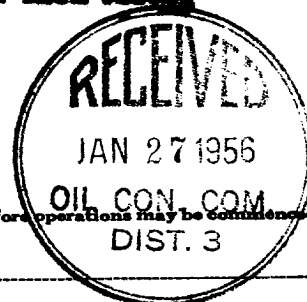

DETAILS OF WORK

Drill 11 inch hole set 7 inch surface pipe circulated to surface with 75 sacks cement. Drill 6 1/4 inch hole to approximately 2800 feet to test the Pictured Cliffs formation. Set 4 1/2 inch O. D. 9 1/2 J55 casing through Pictured Cliffs and test and fracture with water and sand and complete with 1 inch tubing as siphon line.



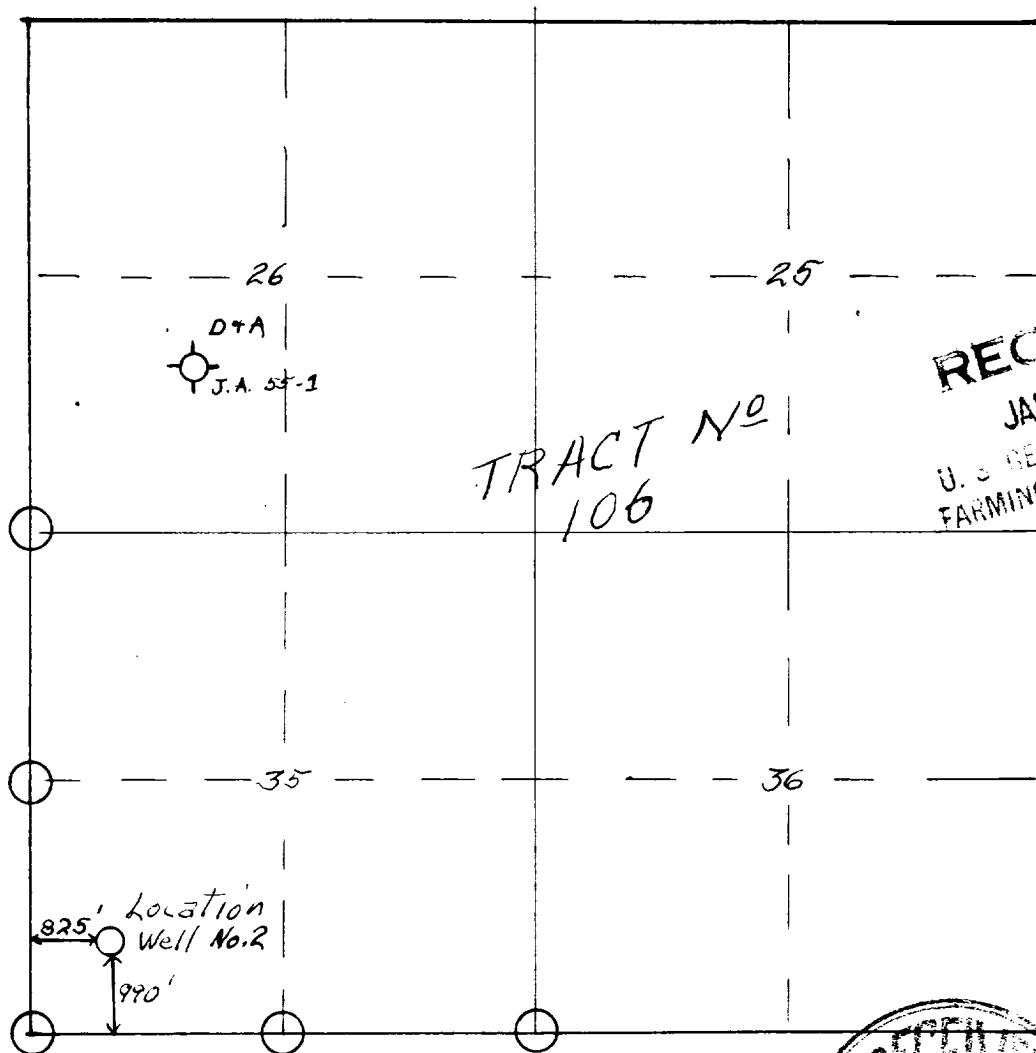

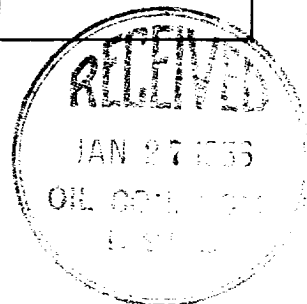
