Set 95' 8 5/8" 24# Surface Casing at 107' with 75 sacks regular cement with 2% Calcium Chloride. Drilled to total depth of 3080', and plugged back to 3043'.

Set 3043' 4 1/2" 9 5/8" J-55 casing with 100 sacks 50-50 Pos-Mix with 2% Calcium Chloride.

After setting casing, operations were temporarily suspended because of weather conditions. As soon as weather conditions permit, well will be perforated and water-fraced preparatory to placing on production for the production of gas.

Instructions
