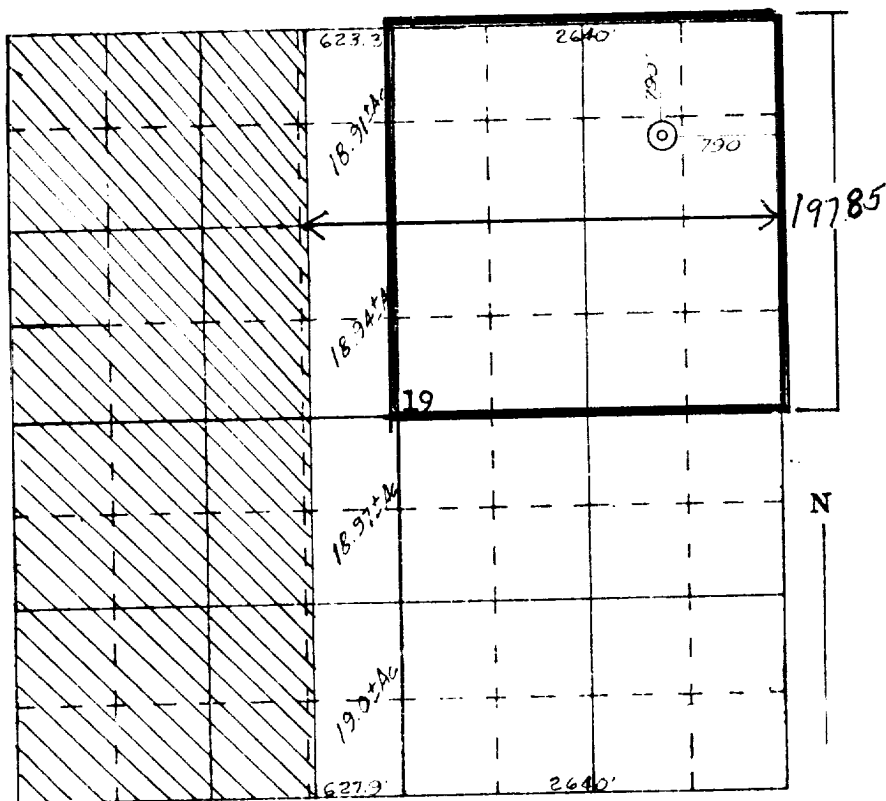

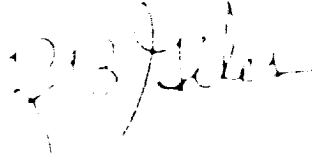

Dear Mr. Porter:

Arapahoe Drilling Company drilled and completed in July, 1968, its Cinco Diablos No. 11 well in Unit "B" of Section 19, T23N-R4W, Sandoval County, New Mexico. Arapahoe desires to include the two lots on the west side of Section 19 in order to increase the allowable for their referenced well from 1.0 acres to 197.97 acres.

This will constitute our waiver letter to you indicating that Pan American, as leasehold owner of adjoining Sections 24 and 25, T23N-R4W, to the west and southwest of said Section 19, has no objection to the Commission's granting Arapahoe such an allowance due to the irregular size of Section 19.
