Federal Media #3 well completed in Gallup formation 2826'-3019' in June 1969. Produced small amount oil (approximately 907 bbls cum.) to August 1969 at which time it was shut in as a non-commercial producer.

Pumped well June - July 1973. Made 40 barrels water per day with scum of oil.

Well is not a commercial producer in Gallup and propose converting to salt water disposal well. Work to be accomplished by removing rods and tubing and utilization of existing perforations. Will lay water line from pit and injection pumps at Federal Media #1 and #2 well and pump water to Federal Media #3 well.

Application to Oil Conservation Commission for Administrative Order SWD - 115 per Rule 701 (c) is being made.
