Subject: Water well

Pan American Petroleum Corporation has drilled a dry hole in the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ of section 7, T. 22 N., R. 2 W., Sandoval County, New Mexico, on Jicarilla lease Contract No. 358. The well has not been plugged.

The operator has advised this office that it may be possible to complete this well as a water well. The well would have to be pumped to produce water. The water source would be the Ojo Alamo formation at about 1000 feet from the surface.

Please advise if the Jicarilla tribe would be interested in accepting the hole above the Ojo Alamo formation as a possible water well. If so, we will request Pan American to plug the well to the base of the Ojo Alamo and leave the upper portion open for completion as a water well.
