Lessees of Record in the area


Electric log showing the producing interval on the

Please advise if further information is required or if a formal hearing is required.

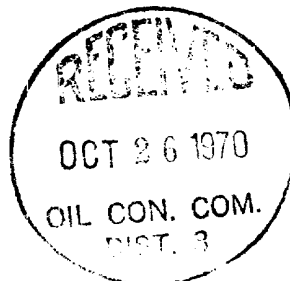
