Dear Mr. Mannon:

We have received two copies of Federal Notice of Intention to Drill for your well in the southwest quarter of Section 13, Towndhip 21 North, Range 5 West, Sandoval County, New Mexico. The Surveyor's plat attached is not on Commission Form C-102 as required. I am sending you a supply of this form. The plat submitted will suffice for the well location so it will not be necessary to have the surveyor sign the new plats. However, you should answer the questions as indicated for acreage dedication and line the acreage dedicated, sign for the operator on the right side of the form and submit five copies to the United States Geological Survery office in Durango, Colorado. They will in turn mail us two copies. As your well is a wildcat oil well, 40 acres is the proper acreage dedication.

I also note that you have not given the well a lease name. Will you please indicate what the lease name will be and I will fill in the information on your application for permit to drill?
