Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

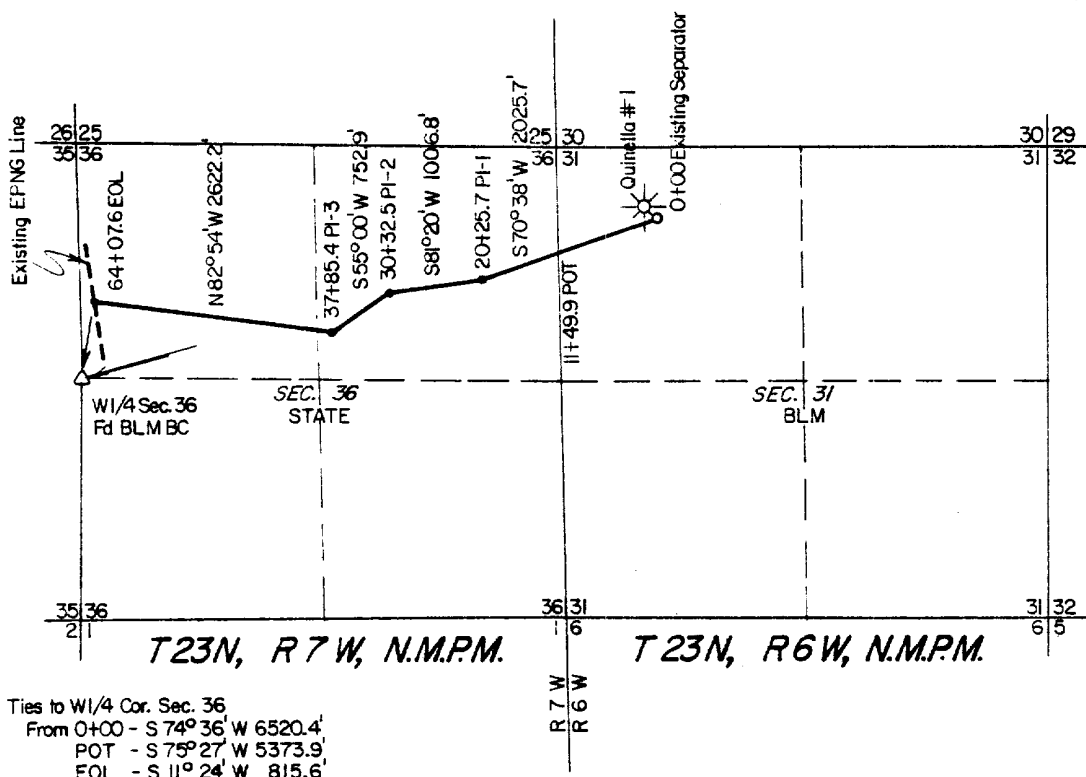
EFFECT OF NOT PROVIDING INFORMATION: Filing of this notice and report and disclosure of the information is mandatory once an oil or gas well is drilled.

A Gas Line Easement and Right-of-Way being a strip of land 40 feet wide over and across a portion of the N 1/2 of Section 36, T. 23 N., R. 7 W., N.M.P.M., Sandoval County, New Mexico. Said easement lying 20 feet each side of the following described centerline;

Beginning at Engineer's Station 11+49.9, said point being on the East line of said Section 36, from which the W 1/4 Corner of said Section 36 bears S 75° 27' W a distance of 5373.9 feet;

Thence: S 70° 38' W a distance of 875.8 feet to Engineer's Station 20+25.7;
 Thence: S 81° 20' W a distance of 1006.8 feet to Engineer's Station 30+32.5;
 Thence: S 55° 00' W a distance of 752.9 feet to Engineer's Station 37+85.4;
 Thence: N 82° 54' W a distance of 2622.2 feet to Engineer's Station 64+07.6 and the End of Line, from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 36 bears S 11° 24' W a distance of 815.6 feet.
