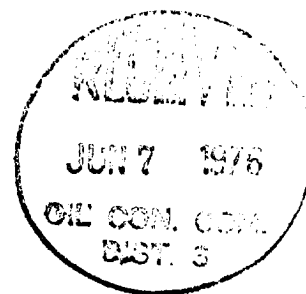
On your computer reports these wells are listed as temporarily abandoned.
