Dear Ms. Dinning:

According to our phone conversation Wednesday, June 11, 1997, I am verifying by letter that the above referenced wells have come under the directive of NMOCD Rule 705-C. This rule states that whenever there is a continuous six-month period of non-injection into any injection project, storage project, salt water disposal well, or special propose injection well, such project or well will be considered abandoned. Therefore, the authority for injection will automatically end.

Connie, if Merrion O&G intends to use any of the above referenced wells in the future for injection they will have to be repermitted for injection before they can be utilized.
