Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Application for Permit to Drill Well No. 6 Fluid Power Pump, located in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sec. 23, T. 19 N., R. 3 W., NMPM, Sandoval County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease NM-8393-A. Application for Permit to Drill was approved April 28, 1972. Fluid Power Pump Company was operator and record lessee in 1972. Lease NM-8393-A was unitized in the Media Entrada Unit November 1, 1975, with Petro-Lewis Corporation as unit operator.

Drilling had been approved but had not commenced. Inspections have shown that the access roads and location were built in 1972 and that the surface has not been restored. The road and location will have to be rehabilitated to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Land Management. Rehabilitation requirements will be sent to you at a later date. Bond on this lease will be held until this location is satisfactorily restored.

Approval to drill is rescinded this date and Application is returned herewith. If at some later date you decide to drill at this location, it will be necessary to file a new application which complies with NTL-6.
