On March 5, 1974, pursuant to telephone conversation with Mr. Arnold with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Aztec, this well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

- 150' cement plug from 5790' TD to 5640' across top of Entrada formation.
- 600' cement plug from 4990' to 4390' across Dakota Sandstone formation.
- 150' cement plug from 2180' to 2030' across top of Point Lookout formation.
- 100' cement plug in and out of 8-5/8" casing at 310'.
- 10 sack cement plug and marker at surface.
