Bennett Federal #1 was completed as a gas well from the Menefee 4-5-74 at a total depth of 330'. The 7" surface casing was set at 30' and cement circulated. A 6 1/4" hole was drilled to total depth and 4 1/2" casing set at 312' and cemented with 35 sacks Class A. Completion is in open hole from 312'- 330'. No other productive zones were found in the well, and no casing is recoverable.

The limited capacity of the producing zone and the distance from a market has caused #1 Bennett Federal to be shut-in since completion.

It is proposed to plug the well as follows:

- Kill well with water by circulating thru tubing in the well.
- Circulate cement from total depth to surface using 30 sacks cement thru tubing insuring that annulus is also cemented to surface behind 4 1/2" casing.
- Remove wellhead connections and head.
- Install marker, clear location, and complete any additional restoration work as required.

After surface work is completed, notification will be given for approval of final abandonment. Work is expected to begin about September 1, 1983.
