Petroleum Development Corporation, under Designation of Operator from Johney M. Myers, drilled the No. 1 San Luis-Federal well in the NW\sk\rac{1}\ sec. 21, T. 18 N., R. 3 W., Sandeval County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease Santa Fe O81160-F. They forwarded a copy of an agreement letter to this office indicating that you have accepted responsibility for the well.

In order for you to assume operations of this well, you must submit an original and two copies of Designation of Operator to this office whereby Johnsy H. Myers, record lessee, designates Hoel Raynolds as operator of the applicable acreage for the well.

The subject well was temporarily abandoned on May 26, 1974, at a total depth of 1661 feet. Since four potentially productive oil and gas formations were penetrated and only 324 feet of surface casing was set in the well, it is essential that production casing be commuted in the hole or that the well be adequately plugged or shandoned without further delay.

Your cooperation in promptly submitting the required Designation of Operator instrument and an appropriate Sundry Notice to Set Production Casing or Plug and Abandon will be appreciated.
