Southern Union Gas Company desires to drill the San Ysidr - \$1-17, Las Milpas gas storage well. This well is to be located 300' FEL and 500' FNL of Section 18, T15N, R18, N.M.P.M., Sandoval County, New Mexico.

The proposed well site is located approximately Northwest of an existing well (King #1-13).

An access road will be constructed from the existing well (Fing #1-13) Northwest to the proposed well site. No tank batteries are to built. This well is to be drilled for observation purposes only at this tile, therefore, no immediate connection to the existing system is planned or requested.

Waste will be disposed of by placing it in a reserve or large pit constructed according to the attached specifications. This reserve pit will, when dry, be smoothed, lined and used as an emergency splash pit to be able excess water produced during subsurface development and testing.

A small trailer hous will be placed on location for personnel use while drilling operations or in progress.

No air stripe or percentabuildings are to be constructed at the proposed location. As attached must illustrates the rig and location beyont.

Upon completion of deilling operations the wellhead and stated equipment will be painted a color to conform with the surroundings. The location will be cleaned, claded and in-specied so as to have the area in an acceptable natural state.
