

SURFACE USE AND OPERATION PLAN
FOR
JICARILLA 372 #1 NW¼ SECTION 30 T22N R2W
SANDOVAL COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Enclosed is a copy of the U.S.G.S. Topographic map covering the area of the proposed captioned well. Existing roads are shown on this map. The acreage dedicated to this well is outlined in yellow while the location and proposed access roads are colored red.

Water for drilling will be obtained from a local rancher North of the location approximately 12 miles.

Waste disposal will be either burned in the burn pit, latrine or reserve pit as applicable.

There will be no air strip or camp associated with the drilling of this test. Enclosed is a map of the rig and well site layout.

Upon completion or abandonment of the well, the location will be cleaned, leveled and restored and a dry hole marker placed if applicable.

Surface ownership is the Jicarilla Apache Indian Tribe. The terrain at the well site is rolling with drainage to the North into Five Lakes Canyon. Vegetation consists mainly of Juniper and Pinon and some sage brush and various grasses.

Other BLM stipulations will be followed.
