If at some later date you decide to drill this well, it will be necessary to file a new application.

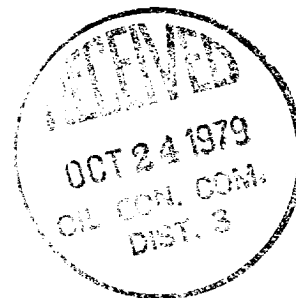
