Well was drilled to a total depth of 622' which was sufficient to test the complete Pictured Cliffs formation. Said formation was water bearing throughout. The Ojo Alamo formation was found to contain fresh water. Nanco, Inc., therewith submitted their well status to the City of Cuba, New Mexico, hoping that Cuba may wish to have the water resources to supplement their local necessities. We thereafter met with the Rio Puerco Water Resources Department (BLM), Albuquerque, New Mexico, to advise said department of our well and to request their consideration and assistance in assigning said water rights to Cuba. We have also met with the Mayor of Cuba, Virginia Sandoval, requesting their prompt consideration of our water rights proposal, wherewith Cuba was advised of the consideration that would be extended to their city government (by the United States Geological Department, Durango, Colorado, and by Rio Puerco Water Resources Department, Albuquerque). Both departments would consider assigning water rights to Cuba within a justifiable period of time. As of December 1, 1977, U.S.G.S. requested that we abandon the well. The well was plugged on January 3, 1978. Cement was circulated from 622' to approximately 390'. The Ojo Alamo water zone was left open from 390' to approximately 94'. A bridge plug was set at 94' and the surface casing was cemented to surface. The well has been abandoned with a surface marker location remaining.
