Dear Mr. Reynolds:

The NMOCD records show that there has not been any injection into the referenced wells in the Torreon San Luis Mesaverde Waterflood Project since June 2, 1982. NMOCD Rule 705.B.l states that whenever there is a continuous six month period of non-injection into any injection project, storage project, salt water disposal well or special purpose injection well, such project or well shall be considered abandoned, and the authority for injection shall automatically terminate ipso facto. This letter will serve as notice that your authority to inject into the referenced wells has been terminated. If, at some later date, you wish to reinject into these wells, it will be necessary to submit a new application (Form C-108) to the Division.
