Gentlemen:

Returned herewith unapproved is your sundry notice requesting temporary abandonment of well No. 1-Y Jicarilla 430, sec. 25, T. 23 N., R. 5 W., Sandoval County, New Mexico, Lease Jicarilla Contract 430. In order to place this well in an acceptable condition for temporary abandonment, it is necessary to place a bridge plug no more than 50 feet above the upper most perforation. Either submit sundry notices for finalizing completion of this well, including the anticipated time the work will be done or a revised request for temporary abandonment, including the required bridge plug. Also, if this well is to be temporarily abandoned, it is necessary that you submit a completion report, Form 2-300.

Any temporary abandonment will be for a period of one year and you will be required at the end of that time to show cause why the well should not be permanently plugged and abandoned. The requested sundry notice and completion report should be received in this office within 30 days from the date of this letter.
