By telephone March 15, 1979, your secretary informed this office that you would not drill Well No. 1 Apache Draw, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 8, T. 22 N., R. 3 W., NMM, Sandoval County, New Mexico on Jicarilla Contract No. 409. Jicarilla Contract No. 409 will expire by its own terms March 27, 1979.

Application For Permit to Drill was approved November 17, 1978, but drilling had not commenced. Any construction of access road or well pad will have to be restored to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Application for Permit to Drill is rescinded this date and is returned herewith. If at some later date you decide to drill a well at this location, it will be necessary to file a new application.
