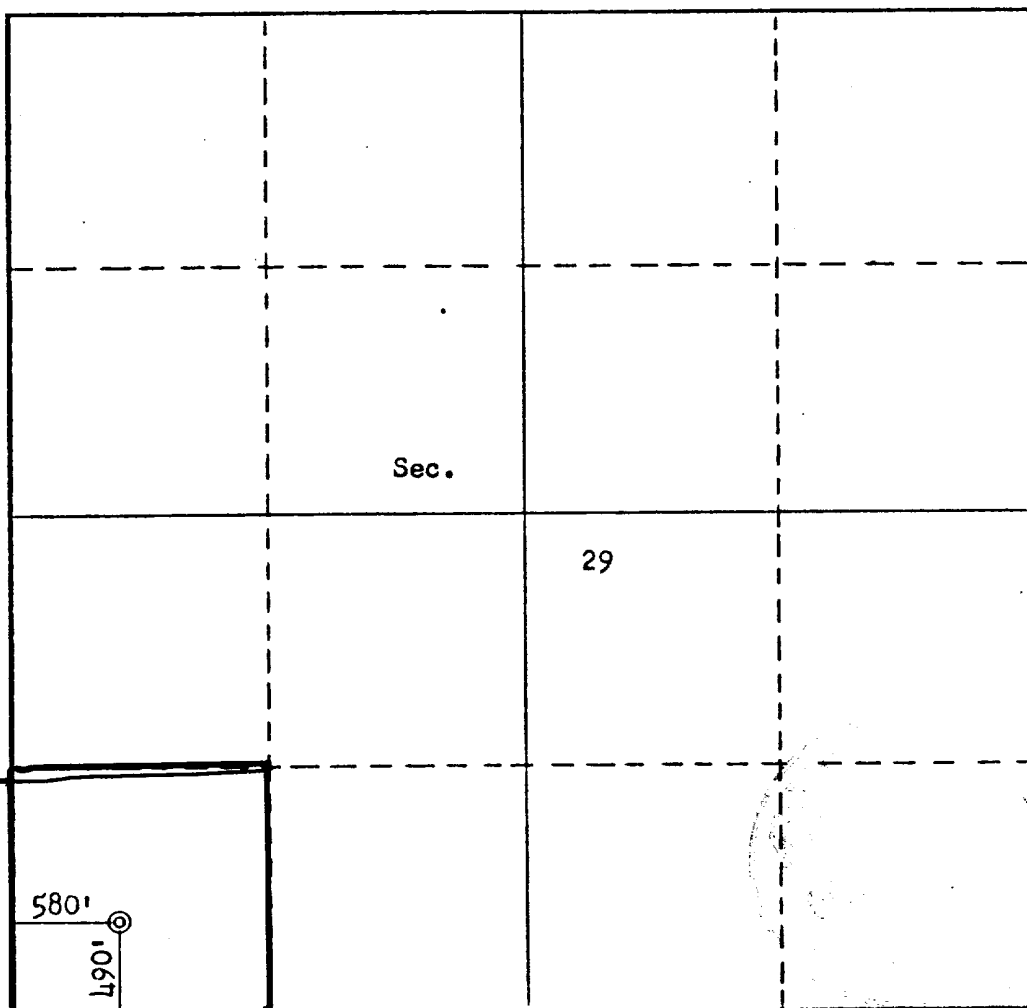

- 1) The attached topo map shows the existing route to the location and distance from Torman Trading Post
- 2) No access roads will be constructed

- 5) No water will be required for drilling

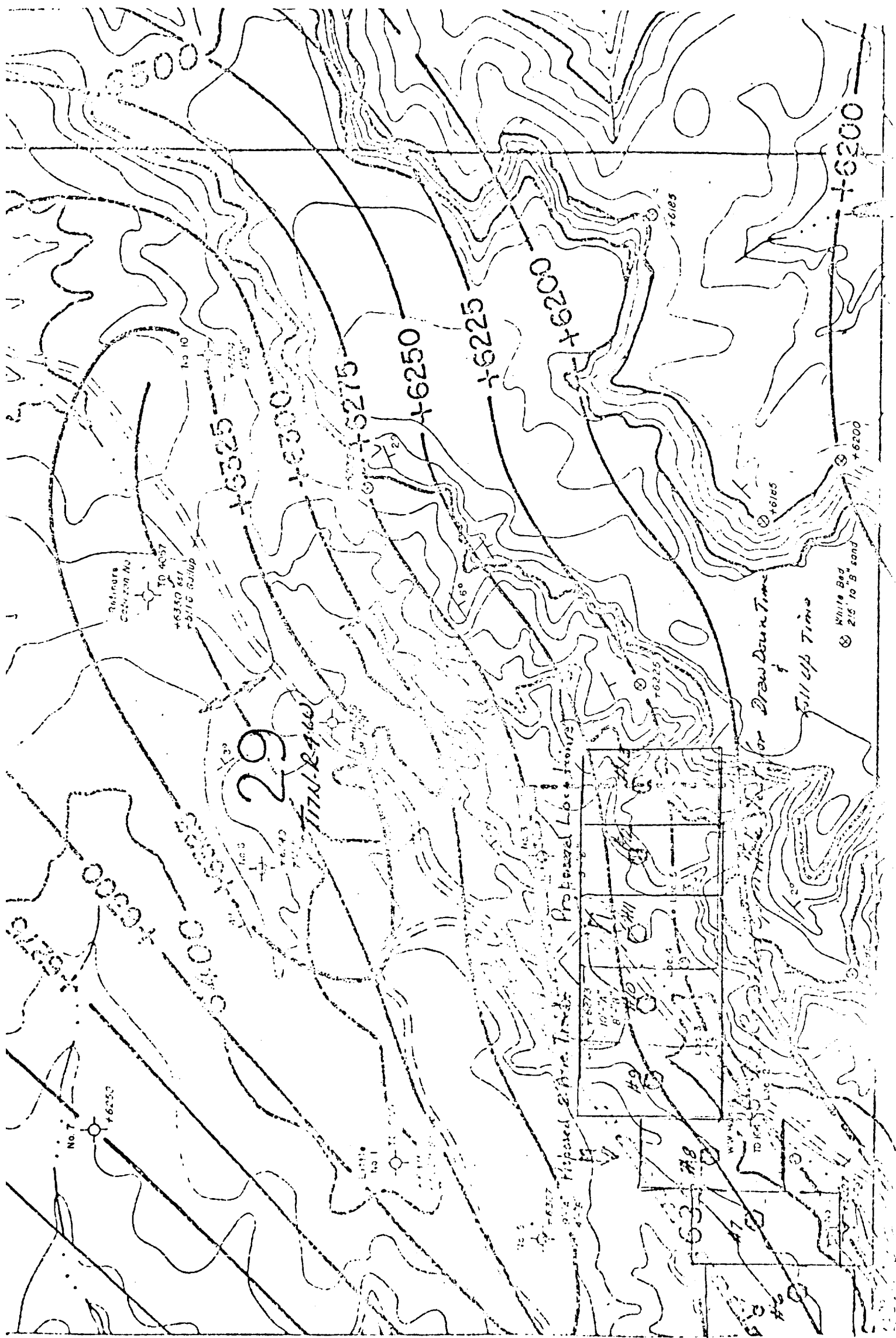

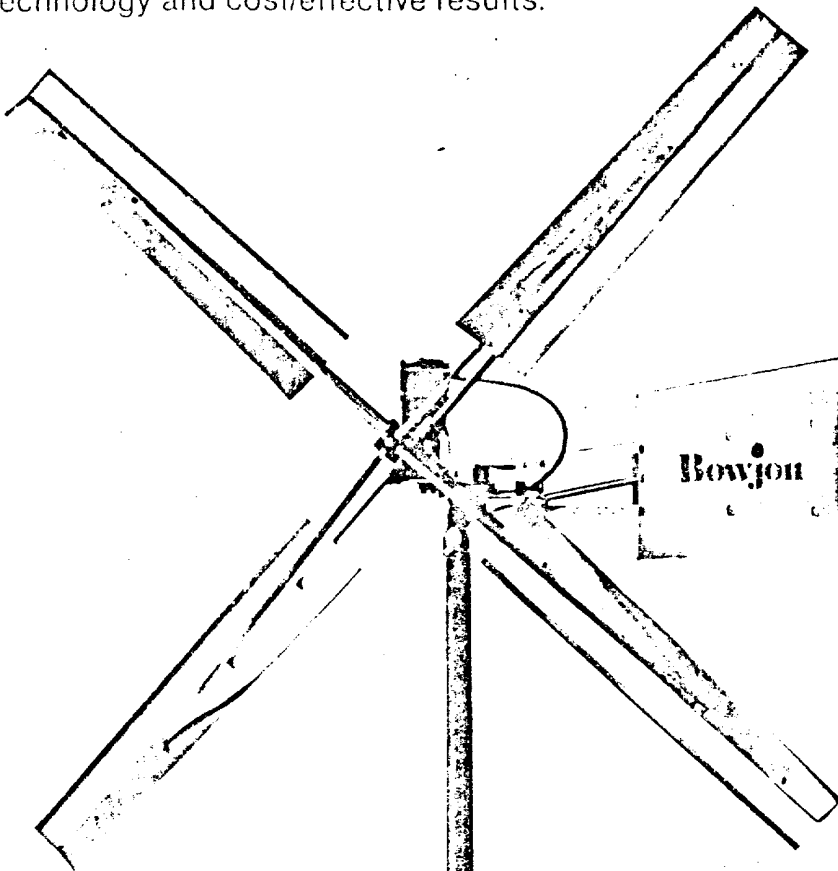
Prospective Productive zone is believed to be gravity flow or water drive - there is no gas drive - no blowout preventer will be needed
