Dear Mr. Keller:

We have been actively working to get the subject shut-in wells on production--to everyone's benefit. Without offering a bunch of excuses, the plunging gas prices of the past year and difficulties inherent to the mixed Federal-Indian land situation have complicated matter--but we are persisting.

We are working with Holcomb Oil & Gas Co. who is trying to get a large number of shut-in wells in this area on production. Availability of bonding has been a major problem but we think we may have this problem solved.

We have satisfied testing and other requirements and have really tried to maintain the viability of this project. Accordingly, we are requesting a six month extension of any additional requirements.
