We request permission to flare the gas produced from our McCroden "C" No. 1 well, located 2146 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 25N, Range 3W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico and our Lybrook "B" No. 1 well, located 2206 feet from the South line and 412 feet from the East line of Section 30, Township 23N, Range 6W, Sandoval County, New Mexico.

We need the additional time so that we can determine the feasibility of building gathering systems to enable us to sell the gas. We should be able to make the evaluation in less than one year.

We ran initial production tests on the wells with the following results:
