Champlin Petroleum Company requests approval of long term shut-in for the subject well. The current depressed oil price market makes this well uneconomic to continue to produce.

The well was shut in on 7/29/86. Production immediately prior to the shut in was 4 BOPD, 25 BWPD and 26 MCFD. In the year immediately preceeding the shut-in, the well produced in paying quantities and averaged 17 BOPD. Approval for long term shut-in would prevent premature abandonment of recoverable hydrocarbon reserves.
