We propose to set a 7" CIBP at 3,400'; Perf Menersee at 2,674' to 2,680' (6' with 2 SP) and 2,802' to 2,809' (7' with 2 SP); Swab test (may or may not need Acid)

The estimated date of starting this proposed work and/or the other work proposed on the San Isidro #14-4, 12-4, 13-11, 5-14, 12-2, and 1-16 is on or before July 26, 2002. The same rig will be used for the work on all of these wells.
