Reference is made to your request for an exception to the tubing setting requirements as contained in Division Rule 107(d)(3) for the below-named well.

Pursuant to the authority granted me by Rule 107(d)(4), you are hereby authorized to set tubing at 3,333 feet in the following well:

Well Name and Number: Johnson 6-16

Unit P, Sec. 6, T-20-N, R-2-W, NMPM, Location:

Sandoval County, New Mexico

Remarks: Due to the high oil flow from this well and the associated safety problems with removing the well head, this temporary order shall remain in effect until the flow rate has decreased sufficiently. At this time, the tubing will be set in accordance with Rule 107 and the District Supervisor of the Aztec office, upon his discretion, shall decide the timely manner in which the referenced

well will comply with Rule 107.

The Division reserves the right to rescind this authority in the event that waste appears to be resulting therefrom.
