Will drill 12-1/4" surface hole to 200 ft. and set 200 ft. of 8-5/8" 24 #/ft. J-55 grade casing with 175 sx Class B cement with 3% CaCl₂. Will drill 7-7/8" hole to 6400 ft. Will run open hole logs. No other testing planned. If well appears productive, will run 6400 ft. of 4-1/2", 10.5 #/ft. J-55 grade casing and stage cement. First stage will cement with 250 sx Class H 2% gel (1.22 cu. ft/sk. yield) 305 cu. ft. cement to cover Gallup interval from TD. Estimated top of cement is 5230 ft. Will set stage collar at approximately 4900 ft., below Point Lookout Formation. Second stage will cement with 700 sx Class B 2% D-79 (2.06 cu. ft/sk.) followed by 50 sx Class H 2% Gel (1.22 cu. ft/sk) 61 cu. ft. to cover Mesaverde, Chacra, Pictured Cliffs, Fruitland and Ojo Alamo. Top of cement will be at surface.

Drilling circulating medium will be low solids, non-dispersed, low water loss mud using bentonite, starch, CMC and fresh water.

Minimum specifications for pressure control is 10" 900 series double ram blow out preventer.

Will perforate and stimulate as required for completion.

GENERAL: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, as indicated, on all types of lands and leases for appropriate action by either a Federal or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. 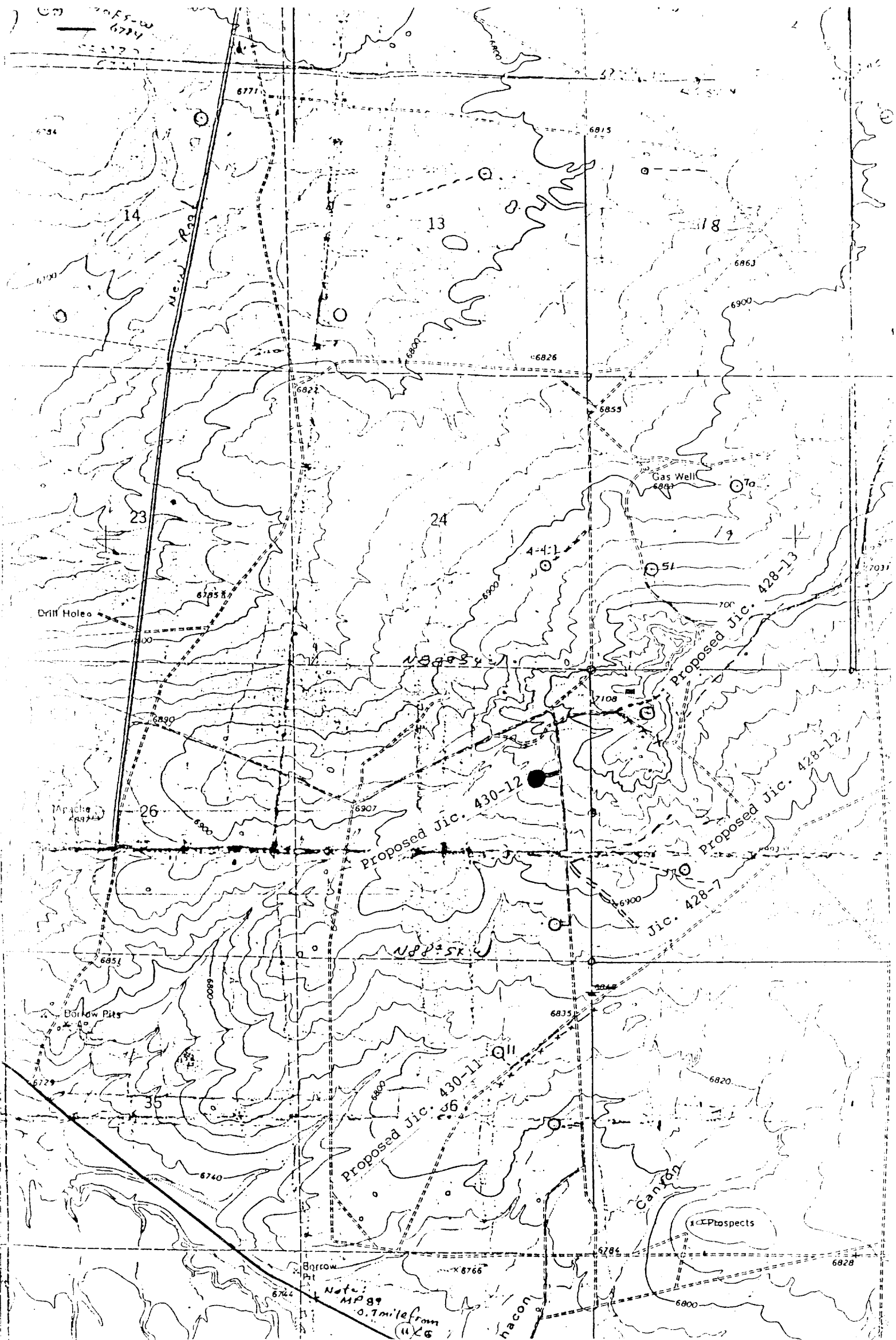
