Your company has been sending C-115 production reports with an incorrect pool code and pool name for the well referenced above. The correct pool code and name is 96899, Eagle Mesa West Entrada. This pool was originally called the WCD3; Entrada as you can see on the copy of the enclosed approved Application for Permit to Drill. I am also enclosing a copy of the original plat which we corrected for our records. The pool name was later changed, however, the pool code remained the same.

Unfortunately, we failed to make corrections to your C-104 when your company sent it with the 2285 pool code and Arena Blanca-Entrada Oil pool.

Please make corrections to your records using pool code 96899 and pool name Eagle Mesa West Entrada. Also, contact Andrea Wheeler at 505-476-3482 or email her at awheeler@state.nm.us to make corrections in the C-115 production reports that have been sent in error. None of the production reported has made it into the ONGARD system because an incorrect pool code has been used. We appreciate your prompt attention in this matter.
