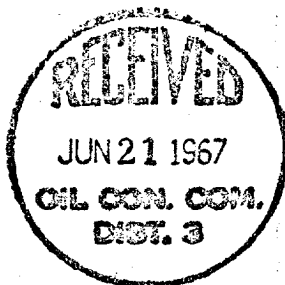

September 16, 1946, we drilled in on Well No. 6, Ann Lease.

The No. 6 well was drilled to a total depth of 460 feet. Good oil shows were encountered at 320' to 360' and 390' to 410'. Casing was set and cement circulated to surface. Again we have tried various chemical treatments in an attempt to complete as a primary commercial producer. At the present, we are re-evaluating for a possible pusher flood.
