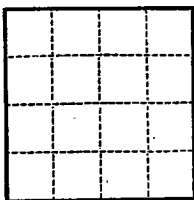

DETAILS OF WORK

The well was drilled to a depth of 975 ft, with cable tools, and no substantial showing of oil was found. The producing zone was carrying about four bailers of water, and one bailer of oil per hour, this finally settled to very little oil, and an increase of water.

Hole will be filled with cement from 875 to 975.
Hole will be filled with mud from 675 to 875.
Hole will be filled with cement from 625 to 675-Water at 650 to 655.
Hole then filled to 20 ft. under surface with mud.
Top 20 ft. of hole to be cemented, and pipe marker set in it.
All casing to be pulled except 74 ft. of demented surface casing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
