Permit is requested to drill a test well 990' from the south and 1290' from the east lines of section 36, T-22N, R-14W, San Juan County, New Mexico, to test the shallow oil pay now producing from the Allison member of the Mesaverde formation.

This unorthodox location is requested due to the highly faulted nature of the structure and the erratic lenticular sand conditions which are found in the Allison member.
