DETAILS OF WORK

1. Plugged at 3700' with 60 sacks cement (3700-3800). Plugged at 3000' with 100 sacks cement. Cleared out to 2800.
2. Ran 3 1/2" 52 2786-3800' (Joint Lockout). Initial shut in 30 min., open 2 hrs., weak steady blow, gradually decreasing at end of test. No gas to surface. Final shut in 1 hour recovered 2236' (1.2 bbls). Water, Salinity recovered water 8250 ppm (t). Mud before test, nil. ISIP failed, IF 100, FI 1250, PSIP 1300, W 1500.
3. Plugged at 600' with 80 sacks cement (400-600'). Plugged at 180' with 50 sacks cement (160-180').
4. Plugged casing with 10 sack cement cap. Installed marker and abandoned in accordance with USGS regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
