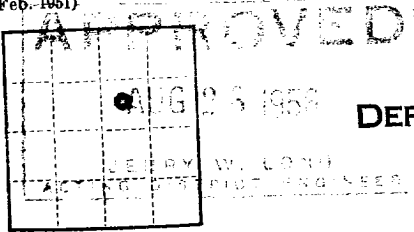

DETAILS OF WORK

The Chaco Unit No. 3 was spudded at 3:30 PM August 17, 1956.

245' of 9-5/8" 36# J-55 8 rmd. thd. casing was set at 255' with 150 sacks of cement August 18, 1956. The cement circulated.

After 2 1/2 hours the casing was pressured with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. There was no pressure drop so drilling was resumed.

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF PLAN

Set 5040' of 5 1/2" 116# J-55 8 rmd. thd. casing with 200 sacks of cement at 5050' instead of 7" 20# J-55 casing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
