The Commission was organized in 1959 by Executive Order of President Eisenhower. Its purpose was to study and report on the state of international cooperation in the field of science and technology, and to recommend ways in which the United States could better cooperate with other nations in this field.

The Commission has held numerous public hearings and has received many suggestions from scientists, engineers, and other interested persons. It has also conducted extensive research into the various problems and opportunities involved in international cooperation in science and technology.

The Commission's report is divided into two main parts. The first part deals with the general principles of international cooperation in science and technology, and the second part deals with specific areas of cooperation.

The Commission believes that international cooperation in science and technology is essential for the progress of mankind, and that the United States should play a leading role in this field.
