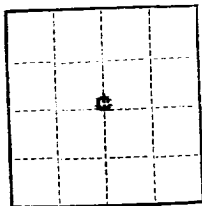

DETAILS OF WORK

We plan to pull 3400' of 5 1/8" casing, placing cement plugs as follows:
(This hole was 7-7/8"), 4740' - 4940' with 65 sacks, 3760' - 3910' with 50 sacks,
1965' - 2115' with 50 sacks, 1220' - 1370' with 50 sacks, 255' - 155' with 35 sacks
and 10 sacks in the top of the 9-5/8" surface pipe.
The location will be properly cleaned and a marker properly placed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
