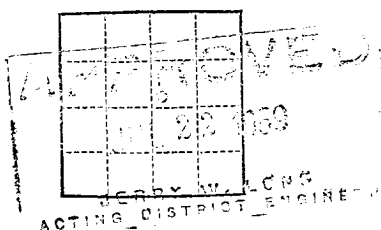

DETAILS OF WORK

We cut and pulled 2000' of 5-1/2" casing. Cement plugs were placed as follows: 4740-4940' 65 sacks, 3710-4110' 50 sacks, 1215-1115' 50 sacks, 1220-1370' 50 sacks, 255-155 35 sacks, and 10 sacks for the top of the 2-5/8" surface pipe. The location has been cleaned and rebed.
