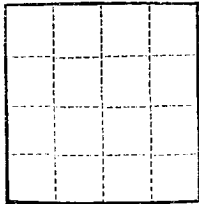

DETAILS OF WORK

The Riddel #1 was plugged as follows:

A 25 sack plug was set at 5340'.

The 7" casing was shot off at 4170' and pulled.

25 sack plugs were placed at 4170', 2800', 2000', and 1200'.

A "Dry Hole" marker with the well name and description was set in the 9-5/8" surface casing with 10 sacks of cement November 2, 1955.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operation and be maintained.
