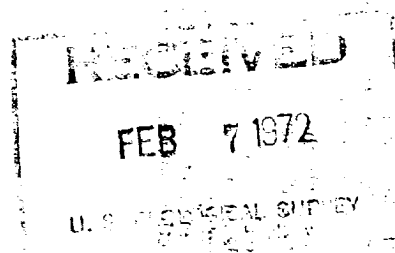
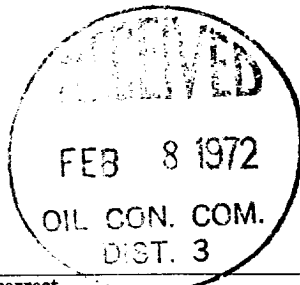

This oil well is uneconomical to produce and plugging is requested to allow removal of material from lease. Last production was in December, 1971 at a rate of 15 BOPD and 63 BWPD. 9 5/8" OD, 32.36#/ft surface casing was set at 1,270' w/650 sms cement. Cement was circulated to the surface. 3 1/2" OD, 15.5#/ft was set at 4,300' w/250 sms cement. Casing perforated at 3,982'-4,008' and 4,018'-4,028'. Propose to set cement retainer at approximately 3,930' and squeeze perforations with 150 sms cement. Shoot off 3 1/2" OD casing as deep as possible and pull same. Set 150' plug (45 sms) 50' in and 100' above casing stop. Set 75 sms plug 1320'-1420' across base of surface casing. Set 10 sms surface plug and marker. Kerr-McGee requests approval to plug this well late in the spring or in the summer after the snow thaws and access can be obtained to the well without undue hardships.

Instructions
