Dear Mr. Gray:


On March 8, 1972, verbal approval was given for plugging and abandonment of the above well with the understanding that Form C-103 would be filed as a notice of intention to plug for formal approval. This form has never been received. We also have not received form C-105, Well Record Form, for this well. On March 27, 1972, Form C-103 was filed as a subsequent report of plugging. On August 3, 1972, we received notice that the location was ready for inspection and inspection was made on August 16. It was found that the reserve pit is still fenced and has not been filled and leveled as required by our rules.

Will you please submit the required information as indicated above and notify us again when you are sure the location is ready for inspection so that we may approve your plugging and abandonment notice?

We also have never received our copy of electric logs run on this well. Please enclose a copy.
