
I have contacted the U. S. G. S. and found that you filed these Notices with them with instruction to withhold Commission copies.

Commission regulations require that these reports be filed with the Commission within twenty days following completion of the well. Actually Sundry Reports on casing, etc. are required to be filed within ten days after the work is accomplished. Our rules do provide that all information will be held confidential for a period of ninety days following completion of the well providing the operator so requests.
