Reference is made to your letter dated February 14, 1977, wherein you request an exception to the provisions of Commission Rule 107(d)(3) for the Dome Petroleum Corporation Santa Fe 20 Well No. 1 located in Unit G of Section 20, Township 21 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the tubing in this well is set at approximately 3000 feet, or some 2600 feet above the top of the pay.

Dome Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized the aforesaid exception to Rule 107(d)(3), provided however that the Commission reserves the right to rescind this approval if it appears that waste or reservoir damage may result therefrom.
