Dear Charlie:

Envirotech Inc. has moved three full loads (60 cubic yards) of bottoms from the pit adjacent to the gun barrel to a recycling center in southeast New Mexico. There are still 20 cubic yards or more of the asphaltic bottoms remaining in the temporary pit. We discussed the issue of space availability in your office with Mr. Denny Foust in regard to landfarming the remainder of the bottoms on-site. This does not seem to be practical due the volume of petroleum hydrocarbon solids remaining on location at the tank battery. There is not enough area left on location to landfarm all of the remaining material.

We are herein seeking your approval to remove one more load of asphaltic solids to a recycling center. Costs to complete this task are as follows:

Trackhoe - Load		\$110.00
Tip Fees - 20 Cubic Yards		\$380.00
Truck liners (material and labor)		\$100.00
Transport w/ Special Waste Permit (1 loads)		\$1,900.00
	Total	\$2,490.00
