
Re: Dome Federal 24-21

Dear Sir:

Petro-Lewis Corporation recently acquired the Dome <u>Federal 24-21</u> from KENAI Corporation. The well is located in Section 24, Township 23 North, Range 8 West. The well was completed on December 24, 1981.

This is an application for a Special Well Test of the Dome Federal 24-21. This application is being made to establish the production of the subject well. The production data obtained during the Special Well Test will be used to either justify the economics of a gas sales system or to apply for venting according to NTL-4A Section 4B #1. Petro-Lewis Corporation does not feel that the 30 day test conducted on this well is sufficient to establish production of the Dome Federal 24-21.

Petro-Lewis Corporation operates a gas gathering system in the area of the Dome Federal 24-21. A gas sales line of approximately 11,500' would be needed to tie into the gas gathering system.
