
The elevation of the ground floor above sea level is 7576 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded June 5, 1962. Set 97' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3410' reached June 11, 1962. Set 4 1/2" casing at 3407' and cemented with 125 sacks. Subject well was perforated from 3130 to 3386' and was sand fraced on July 30, 1962 with 30,000# sand.

Well presently shut-in for testing.
