
In reply to your letter of November 4, 1960 regarding Intention to Drill on the above captioned well, I enclose herewith the following for your approval.

In reply to your statement regarding plugging bond, please be informed that we are farming this out from the Mobil oil Company, of Durango, Colorado, and are operating under all of Mobil's Bonds for all drilling in this area, until we have completed ten (10) wells. We also operated under theirs bonds in the drilling of the # 1 Duff-Goverment in Section 34, and the # 1-A Duff-Goverment in Section 22, both in Twp. 24 North, Range 1 West. All of our future wells will be drilled under the name of Irving Pasternak, who is sole owner of Shar-Alan Oil Company.

Hoping that this meets with your approval. I also enclose as per your request. 2 copies of the Intention to Drill, and 2 copies of the Plat covering the drilling of the # 1A Duff Government in Section 22.
